Membership Benefits and Activities

Regularly Scheduled Club Ice – Club ice is available to all members for purchase during our skating season. Club ice sessions provide a reliable source of ice time to work on skating skills, as well as work with KCFSC approved coaches.

Web Site – The Kansas City Figure Skating Club maintains a club web site, www.kansascityfsc.org that will provide members with information on the club. Skaters can access the site any time and receive the latest news.

E-Mail Group – The Kansas City Figure Skating Club operates an e-mail group for our member's. It is used to notify our members of upcoming events, news, club ice schedule changes, competition results and many other topics. You can sign-up using the e-mail group link on the KCFSC web site.

Skating Magazine – Each family will receive one subscription to the official publication of the United States Figure Skating Association.

Club Directory – Each skating family receives the club directory containing members' names with phone numbers and a copy of the Constitution and By-Laws of the club on an annual basis.

Financial Stipends – Financial assistance is provided to those home club members who compete in qualifying competitions (Regionals, Sectionals, Nationals). The Board of Directors will, on an annual basis, determine financial stipend criteria and amounts. This information will be published on a yearly basis prior to the start of club ice each fall.

Scheduled Test Sessions – Throughout the membership year (July 1 – June 30), KCFSC will sponsor test sessions on a regular basis. This provides continuing opportunities for members to achieve test goals. The club will provide subsidized test fees for home club members in an effort to keep the cost at the lowest level possible for our skating families. Critiques – The member judges of KCFSC are available to provide feedback on programs and tests. Feedback can be arranged by contacting the judges directly.

Club Jackets – Club jackets bearing our club logo are available for purchase at a reasonable rate to our club members.

Skate Kansas City – KCFSC hosts Skate Kansas City each April. This competition is one of the largest in the Midwest and serves as a showcase for our skaters to demonstrate their skills, as well as compete against other skaters from outside this area.

Awards Banquet – Our annual banquet celebrates the accomplishments of our members over the past skating season. Major awards are given for Most Improved Skater, Sportsmanship, and High Point.

Exhibitions - Prior to qualifying competitions, skaters are given the opportunity to participate in an exhibition. This gives the skater the opportunity to perform his/her programs in full costume before an audience.

Social Events – Club parties and activities are offered periodically through the year. Some of these events include Hairy-Scary (our Halloween event), a Holiday Party in December and skating party at the Crown Center Ice Terrace.
