Club Ice 2011 - 2012

Skaters who have passed Basic Skills Level 4 or higher are eligible to purchase club ice. The emphasis here is safety. Be aware that there may be high-level skaters on any session.

Skating Season/Schedule

The 2011 – 2012 skating season will run from Monday, August 22, 2011 through Monday, May 21, 2012. The times are as follows:

Please note that the Clubs reserve the right to pre-empt any portion of any session upon reasonable notice for special events.

Contract and Walk-on Info

There are two ways to pay for club ice. A skater may contract specific session(s) and/or may purchase walk-on sessions.

A maximum of 26 skaters will be allowed on a session. In the event that a session becomes full, skaters that have contract ice will have first priority. Walk-on and make-up skaters will then be allowed on a first-come, first-serve basis. If a session is full, then a skater may take the place of an absent contract skater 5 minutes into the skating session according to the clock by the ice. **Each skater needs to check in with the ice monitor upon arrival.** If a skater does not check-in with the ice monitor, the ice monitor is not responsible for the availability of ice for that skater.

Payment Information

The fee structure is as follows:

Payments may be made to the ice monitors in the form of cash or check. There is a \$30.00 late fee charged for any late payment. There is a \$30.00 fee for a returned check. A laptop may be available at some sessions to pay using Paypal or credit card. Check with the ice monitors for information.

Rules for Skaters/Parents/Coaches

All members are expected to follow proper skating etiquette. Current club rules are as follows:

- 1) All members must be courteous and respectful both on and off the ice. All skaters and professionals must strive to avoid on-ice collisions. Skaters must be careful around those at a higher or lower skating level.
- 2) The skater whose music is playing has the right-of-way. This skater must be wearing a sash provided by the clubs. Other skaters and coaches **must yield** to the skater wearing the sash.
- 3) Skaters in lessons have right-of-way priority immediately below the priority given to the any skater wearing the sash.
- 4) Skaters and coaches should not linger in the Lutz corners and should move out of the area as soon as possible. Spins should be practiced in the middle area of the rink.
- 5) Ice time is for skating. If extended conversations (other than with coaches) are necessary, the skaters should leave the ice. **Skaters who wish to hold extended conversations need to sit on the bench.**
- 6) The only individuals allowed to give instruction to skaters on any club session are KCFSC/SBFSC Home Club and Associate Professional members approved by USFS. Guest coaches must have prior approval from the KCFSC/SBFSC Ice Committee.
- 7) Observers must watch from the bleachers and are not allowed to stand by the boards.
- 8) The only individuals that are allowed in the hockey boxes during a club session are contracted skaters, ice monitors, officials, and coaches.
- 9) Skaters must not wear iPods, MP3 players, or other such electronic devices as they may prevent skaters from being fully aware of others who may have priority. These devices may be played through the stereo system.
- 10) Coaches are limited to two skaters per lesson and must be actively coaching to skate free of charge.

If there are any questions about these rules during a session, please see the ice monitor on duty. The ice monitors, at their discretion, may ask any skater to leave the ice who they determine are not in compliance with the above rules. A first non-compliance warning will be given before any skater is asked to leave. **The rules set forth herein are for the safety of skaters and coaches, so they should be taken seriously.** These rules are subject to change as determined by the KCFSC/SBFSC Ice Committee and notice of any such change will be provided.

Music Rules

Any skater may have his or her music played during a club ice session. Skaters should submit their CDs to the announcer's box at the beginning of a session. CDs will be played in the order submitted with the following exception:

- Coaches may move a skater's music to the top of the order if that skater is in a lesson.
- Coaches may only pre-empt twice during a given lesson.

Music may only be played three times in one session. A CD may not be restarted except by a coach or in the case of a technical difficulty. After a skater's music is played, it will be placed at the end of the line.

2011 – 2012 Ice Contract Information

Contract Terms and Conditions

The term of this contract is from August 22nd, 2011 through May 21th, 2012.

Skaters may skate the sessions for which they have contracted. A skater may skate other sessions using a make-up session. Contracted skaters will be allowed to make up sessions based on the following: for every hour of contract ice, each skater will be allowed four make-up sessions per year. For example, a skater who has contracted 2 hours per week will be allowed 8 make-up sessions. Make-up sessions expire at the end of the season, and make-up sessions have no monetary value. A session must be missed before a make-up can be used.

On a full session, contracted skaters have first priority. Once all twenty-six (26) slots per session are full, no other ice will be sold on a contract basis and only slots for contract skaters who are absent on a given day will be made available for walk-on skaters. All walk-ons or make-ups are on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Skaters are allowed to change one contracted session to any available contract session once in the lifetime of the contract, provided that the session the skater is moving to is not full. Any additional change(s) to the contracted session(s) is subject to a \$30.00 change fee.

Any skater contracting for ice between August 29, 2011 and March 1, 2012 will have their contract pro-rated for that portion of the season remaining, provided the contract is received with the payment for the next quarter. Pro-rating will be reflected on the next billing cycle. Contracts received after March 1, 2012 must be submitted with the ice fees paid in full to be accepted.

If a skater leaves the sport, this contract can be relinquished to the club with a 50% payment of the remaining ice balance. A contract may be transferred to another skater if the balance of the contract is paid in full. Contracts not paid in full 90 days after the final bill will be sent to an agency for collection. Fees and costs associated with collection of past due accounts will be the responsibility of the skater.

Injuries

If a skater is injured during the span of this contract, the skater is still responsible for timely payment of their contract. An injured skater can submit a written request to the KCFSC/SBFSC Ice Committee for review and possible adjustment to their bill. Medical documentation from a physician must be submitted for review. If an adjustment is granted, in no case will the adjustment be greater than 50% of the time off the ice. After a return to any ice surface, the skater is no longer considered injured.

Lump Sum Payment: Lump Sum payment must be submitted with this contract.

Quarterly Payments: Quarterly installments will be due at the time of contract, November 1, January 1 and March 1. You will be sent a bill on those dates. Payment is due on receipt and accounts will be considered late thirty (30) days after the issuance of statements. Any skater, whose payment is late will not be allowed to test or compete until the bill is brought up-to-date, including any late fees. Any sessions that are pre-empted will be credited to your account. Non-payment of bill may result in the total amount due being sent to an agency for collection.

Monthly Payments: The first of the ten (10) month payments must be submitted with this contract, and each additional monthly payment thereafter must be submitted by the 1st of the month for the months of September through May. You will be sent a bill on those dates. Payment is due on receipt and accounts will be considered late ten (10) days after the issuance of statements. Any skater, whose payment is late will not be allowed to test or compete until the bill is brought up-to-date. Any sessions that are pre-empted will be credited to your account. Non-payment of bill may result in the total amount due being sent to an agency for collection.

Please note that the club has contracted with the rink for the above ice times. Therefore, we are contracting ice to our members for the full time period stated for the entire skating season. Inability to receive lessons during your contracted sessions is NOT grounds for voiding this contract. Please check with your coach before contracting. The Clubs reserve the right to cancel, limit or reschedule ice sessions, as deemed necessary. Funds paid for sessions so cancelled will be refunded.

This agreement will be governed by the laws of Kansas. Any legal action taken due to disputes arising from this agreement shall be brought in the Johnson County, Kansas District Court.

I hereby release the Kansas City Figure Skating Club and Silver Blades Figure Skating Club, along with their officers and members, from any responsibility for injuries suffered during club ice. I agree to abide by the clubs' regulations, ice rules, music procedures, and to pay ice fees in a timely fashion according to the contract terms and conditions.
